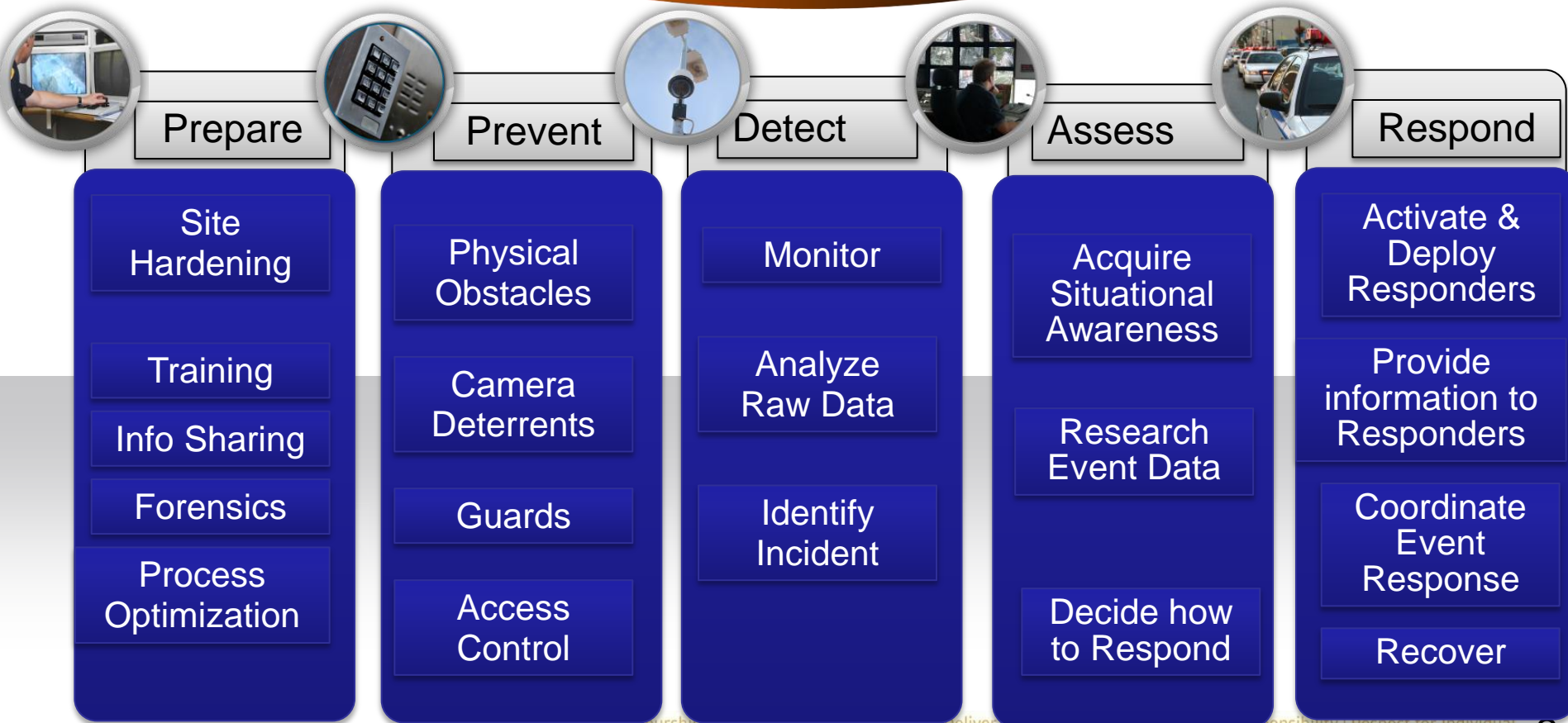

- Detection, prevention, identification, protection, neutralisation and containment of effects of terrorism & crime

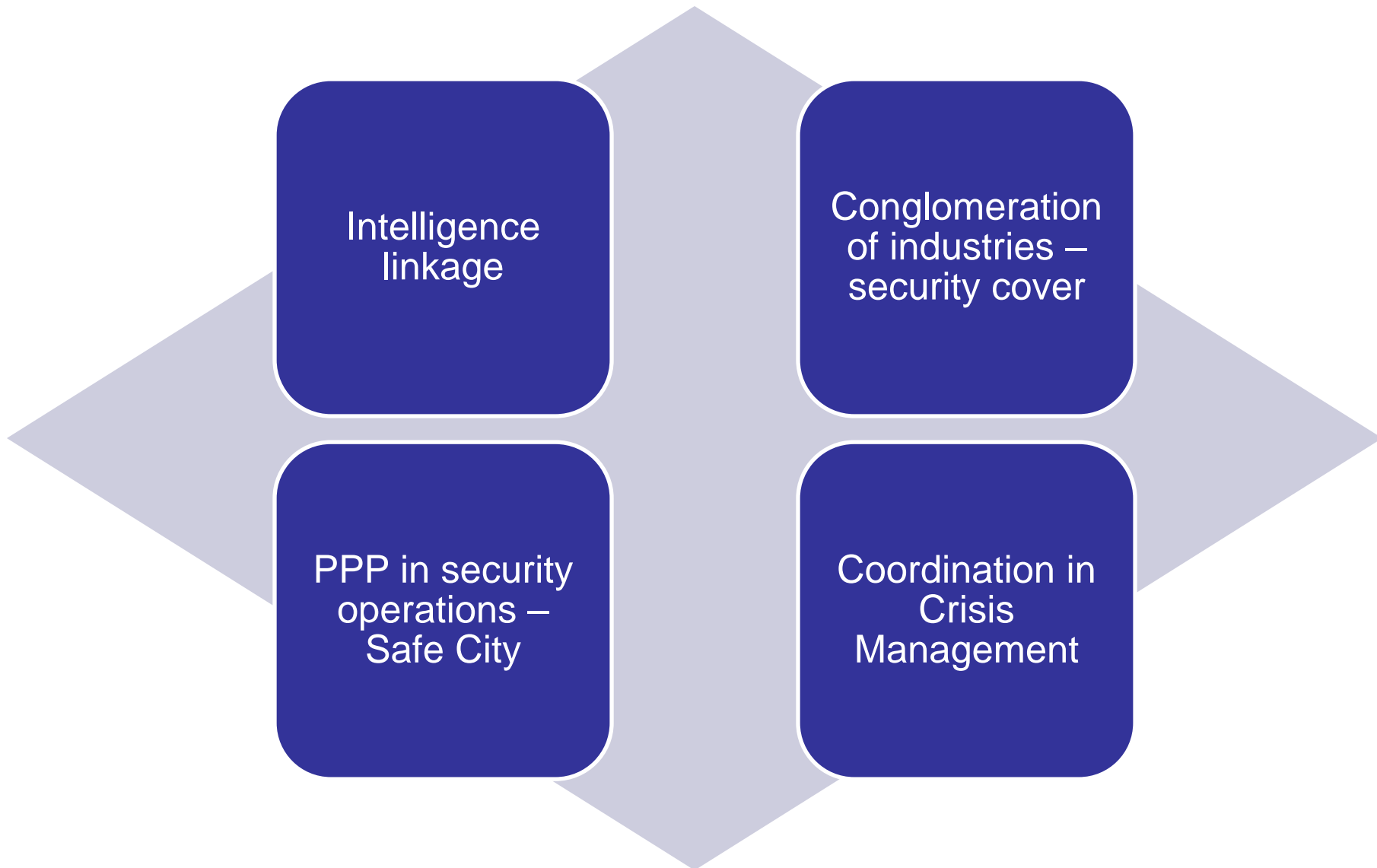
Border security – land and sea frontiers
